- A. Because composing [music] wasn't for serious people.

- 5. Name the piece that Rachmaninoff performed during his public debut as a pianist.
- A. Prelude in C# Minor.
- 6. How successful was his first symphony after it debuted in 1897?
- A. Not successful.
- 7. At what age did he marry his first-cousin?
- A. 29
- 8. In 1915, his old school friend died, what is the name of his friend/composer?
- A. Alexander Scriabin
- 9. In what year did Rachmaninoff move to New York city?
- A. 1918.
- 10. In 1942, after having health issues, to which California city did he move to?
- A. Beverly Hills.
- 11. Did Rachmaninoff have small hands?
- A. Nope.
