Title of Lesson: Collagraph Prints

Intro to video:

Collagraphs are prints of collages... a beautiful and exciting type of print, which is pretty new, and has all kinds of exciting possibilities. I'll show you how to make an abstract print here - but you can make this into a picture of something too - if you'd like.

Steps:

- 1: Make a collage! Use whatever you have around the house and think about using things with different textures. (57 sec)
- 2: Coat the collage in glue and let it dry completely (a couple of hours, overnight, whatever is best for you). (3 min 35 sec)
- 3: Paint acrylic paint onto the collage, working quickly. We'll practice different kinds of color mixing here but you can use whatever paint you have. Please still do the project if you have only one color... it's going to look amazing whatever you do. :) (5 min 12 sec)
- 4: Put a piece of paper on top of your painted collage and press it with your hands. (6 min 28 sec)
- 5: Quickly peel the paper off. (6 min 38 sec)
- 6: Try printing again with different colors if you have them! Print as many as you want to - this is such a fun printmaking project, you can make a lot! (7 min 28 sec)
- 7: I will show you how a few different materials look... keep on printing friend! (9 min 20 sec)
