Title of Lesson: Color Wheel Spinners

Intro to video: These easy to make spinning paper circles are cool paper tops that you draw on to mix colors together in your eyes! That's called Optical Color Mixing! We're going to talk about the color wheel too! You'll draw a pattern with alternating primary colors on a paper circle, and tape something small to the bottom. Then spin!! The primary colors will move so fast they'll look like secondary colors! These are so much fun you'll want to make more than one to try out different colors and patterns. So much possibility!!

Sections

1. Talk about colors and how they mix with a color wheel, and also with optical mixing (like we'll try here).
2. Build Color Wheel Spinners using thick paper or paper and cardboard. (Starting at 2 min 10 seconds)
 - a. Cut Circles (2 min 25 sec)
 - b. Draw color patterns (3 min 30 sec)
 - c. Tape bead or bean to bottom (5 min 50 sec)
 - d. Spin!! (7 min 5 sec)
