Title of Lesson: Sketch Books!

Intro to video: Let's make sketch books! A sketch book is a book that artists fill with all kinds of drawings. You can use your sketch book to draw anything at all! I'll show you how to make 3 different kinds of sketch books here, using materials you probably have at home. The first two sketch books use a stapler, and the last one uses thread. The last sketch book is for people who are over 10 (who have help from adults), and it's at the end of the video – so you can skip it if you want.

Sections:

1. Let's talk about sketch books, and what they're good for (hint... they're good for nearly everything!).
2. The first sketch book is made from regular printer paper, with a cover made from printer paper (you can use construction paper if you want). (50 sec)
3. The second sketch book is made from regular printer paper that's cut in half. It has a cover that's a different color, but otherwise is just regular paper... you can use construction paper too if you have it. (3 min 20 sec)
4. Stop here if you're done with a sketch book, and not interested in sewing a book. Once you have a book made you can start drawing! (5 min 20 sec)
5. The third sketch book is sewn with a regular needle and thread (this is the one for older folks), and uses regular printer paper – and has a thicker paper cover.
